Community members can now meet with Housing Navigators at conveniently located hubs to get help resolving a potential or current housing crisis.

Services

- Offer guidance and help work toward a strategic resolution.
- Identify community resources.
- Develop an individualized housing plan that accounts for long-term housing stability.
- Connect people experiencing homelessness to emergency shelter (based on availability).
- Complete Coordinated Access Intake to determine eligibility for housing resources.
- Support community members matched to housing program through Coordinated Access.
- Provide short-term case management.
