Topics Discussed:

- **House America Tracker Housing Creation:** It was reported that the Affordable Housing Pipeline Tracker reports 2,528 (158%) total units in the pipeline, 232 completed and 329 that are projected to be closed by December 31, 2022. There are 832 Extremely Low-Income Units in the Pipeline, of which 107 are Permanent Supportive Housing Units.
- **House America Tracker Rehousing:** It was reported that Baltimore had met its 2022 House America goal to rehouse 1,000 households in September 2022. A new goal to house an additional 350 individuals, families and youth were set for the fourth quarter of 2022. As of December 31, 2022, Baltimore has housed 1,443 households (144%).
- **Housing Creation Update:**
 - The Home ARP Reallocation Plan will be submitted to HUD by the end of March 2023.
 - A Listening Session was held on December 12, 2022, with the CoC Housing Committee to discuss the Housing Accelerator Fund.
 - The CoC Housing Committee provided additional feedback, it was reviewed and discussed in the January 25th meeting.
- **Rehousing Update:**



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- Hospital Partnerships (ACIS, Medical Respite and Aging Services): All but one of the hospitals have committed to the funding match for ACIS. This will be a one-year commitment, with the opportunity for additional funding in future years.
- Coordinated Access (Flex Funds, Non-Congregate Shelter Acquisition, Shelter Demobilization/RR, Housing Navigation):
 - The Housing Coordinator and Housing Identification positions are in the process of being hired and the collaboration with Enoch Pratt Library has been established.
- Landlord Engagement:
 - The Listening Session with the Landlords went well, and valuable feedback was shared to facilitate the creation of the Landlord Incentive Fund.
 - Padmission will go before the BOE the first week of February.
