Topics Discussed:

- **House America Tracker - Rehousing:** As of September 6, 2022, Rehousing has met 98% of its goal. Singles households are 109% to goal, families 157%, Youth 105%, and Veterans 70%. There has been increased focus on data quality and collecting exit destinations at MOHS, which has resulted in more accurate and complete reporting of outcomes.
- **House America Tracker – Housing Creation: DHCD** is currently tracking over 1,800 total housing units, including over 1,600 units of affordable housing for incomes below 80% AMI, with 600 targeted for households with incomes less than 30% AMI, and about 70 units of Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH). This past month two projects totaling 178 units closed on initial financing and are reported as progress towards the 1,605 goal.
- **Rehousing:** There are three ARPA-funded Initiatives focused on rehousing. They are:
 - Shelter Demobilization and Rapid Rehousing
 - Housing Coordination, Shelter Diversion, and Flex Fund
 - Landlord Engagement, Padmission and Landlord Incentive Fund
- **Housing Creation:** It was presented that the 2 major tasks for Housing Creation. They are:
 - HOME-ARP
 - Housing Accelerator Fund
