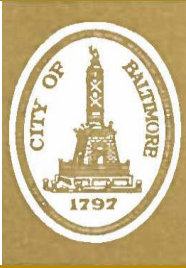

Dear Community Development Partner:

In accordance with Federal Regulations Governing the Consolidated Planning Process, we are notifying you of our intent to amend Annual Action Plans for the following years: PY 2014/CFY 2015; PY 2018/CFY 2019; and PY 2019/CFY 2020.

This amendment generally involves: (1) deleting activities which will not be undertaken at this time, (2) decreasing funding amounts for activities undertaken by community organizations and government agencies to reflect unspent funds, and (3) providing funding for new activities. The Amendment includes CDBG activities funded by the Department of Housing and Community Development, and HOPWA activities funded by the Mayor's Office of Homeless Services.
